

You know this as Krape Park. Originally it was Globe Park and as you can see, there was a very active boating community in Freeport. I believe the current bridge stands where this bridge was. The original dam was constructed of wood and in its same location. Later it was rebuilt as a concrets structure. That structure had a fish ladder to allow fish migration. Not having any documentation on the fish ladder performance it was omitted during the last rebuild. A rock ramp rebuild would allow fish passage and improve habitate.
